Brief History of Quebradas Road

- 24.5 mile Backcountry Scenic Byway dedicated in 1991.
- The road was largely constructed or improved to the current state in the late 1970's
- In 2013, Socorro County Roads Department made several Emergency repairs with FEMA funds
- In 2014, BLM made repairs at 7 drainage crossings with Federal Highway Administrations (FHWA) & Emergency Relief for Federally Owned Roads (ERFO) funding

Conclusion:

- SFO are currently prepping for Spring Work
- BLM engineers will identify and prioritize 4 to 5 LWC for Spring repair/maintenance

- Overall goal is to complete identified work prior to next monsoon season
